- Remember that your audience is a group of local businessmen / women, professionals, senior citizens, and service club members who may not appreciate anything too radical or inflammatory in your essay.
- Be sure that your essay is free of typographical, spelling and punctuation mistakes; it should be grammatically correct and representative of the high level of writing that an enlightened senior in high school can produce.
- It is a good idea to have an educated, unbiased person proofread and critique your essay before you submit it.
- We will briefly review your essay before assembling your file and let you know if we think it is inappropriate or needs serious revision. We do not, however, have the time to correct errors or tutor you on the basics of effective essay writing.
